

# Minimum entry requirements for sixth form study (September 2025 entry)

## A - 'General' minimum entry requirements

As stated in our admissions policy, the 'general' minimum entry requirements for admission to the sixth form to study the following qualifications are:

#### **A-Levels**

Five grade 5s at GCSE, including GCSE English Language or GCSE English literature <u>and</u> GCSE Maths.

### **Cambridge Technical Qualifications**

Five grade 4s at GCSE, including GCSE English Language or GCSE English Literature <u>and</u> GCSE Maths.

#### **Combined A Level/Cambridge Technical Qualifications**

Five grade 4s at GCSE, including GCSE English Language or GCSE English Literature <u>and</u> GCSE Maths.

## B - 'Subject-specific' minimum entry requirements

**In addition** to the above, below are the 'subject-specific' minimum entry requirements for admission onto a specific qualification:

#### A-Levels

Art: Grade 6 in GCSE Art (if taken); if not a portfolio entry by arrangement with Head of Art.

**Biology**: Grades 77 in GCSE Science (combined sciences) or Grade 7 in GCSE Biology (separate sciences) **and** Grade 6 in GCSE Maths. *Mathematical Studies will need to be studied in the sixth form as an additional subject, unless A-Level Maths is being studied.* 

**Business Studies:** Grade 5 in GCSE Business Studies (if taken) **and** grade 5 in GCSE Maths **and** grade 5 in either GCSE English Language or GCSE English Literature. *Mathematical Studies will need to be studied in the sixth form as an additional subject, unless A-Level Maths is being studied.* 

**Chemistry**: Grades 77 in GCSE Science (combined sciences) or Grade 7 in GCSE Chemistry (separate sciences) **and** grade 6 in GCSE Maths. *Mathematical Studies will need to be studied in the sixth form as an additional subject, unless A-Level Maths is being studied.* 



**Computer Science**: Grade 6 in GCSE Computing (if taken) **and** grade 6 in GCSE Maths. *Mathematical Studies will need to be studied in the sixth form as an additional subject, unless A-Level Maths is being studied.* 

**Dance:** Students must undergo a formal audition to gain entry to the course.

**Design (Product Design):** Grade 5 in a relevant design area or by arrangement with Head of Design Technology.

**Drama and Theatre Studies**: Grade 6 in GCSE Drama (if taken) **and** grade 6 in either GCSE English Language or GCSE English Literature.

**Economics:** Grade 5 in either GCSE English Language or GCSE English Literature **and** grade 5 in GCSE Maths. *Mathematical Studies will need to be studied in the sixth form as an additional subject, unless A-Level Maths is being studied.* 

**English Language and Literature:** Grade 6 in GCSE English Language **and** grade 5 in GCSE English Literature.

**English Literature:** Grade 6 in GCSE English Literature **and** grade 5 in GCSE English Language.

Film Studies: Grade 6 in either GCSE English Language or GCSE English Literature.

**Food Science & Nutrition:** Grade 5 in GCSE Food Preparation (or equivalent).

Further Maths: Grade 7 in GCSE Maths. A Level Maths will also need to be studied.

**Geography:** Grade 6 in GCSE Geography **and** grade 5 in either GCSE English Language or GCSE English Literature. *Mathematical Studies will need to be studied in the sixth form as an additional subject, unless A-Level Maths is being studied.* 

**History:** Grade 6 in GCSE history (if taken) **and** grade 5 in GCSE English Language or GCSE English literature.

Mathematics: Grade 7 in GCSE Maths.

**Media Studies**: Grade 5 in either GCSE English Language or GCSE English Literature.

Modern Foreign Languages (French, German and Spanish): Grade 6 GCSE French, GCSE German or GCSE Spanish (as appropriate).



**Music**: Grade 6 in GCSE Music (if taken); if not grade 5 in an instrument/singing **or** by arrangement with Head of Music.

**PE:** Grade 6 in GCSE PE (if taken) if not, grades 65 in GCSE Science (combined sciences) or Grade 6 in GCSE Biology (separate sciences) **and** grade 5 in either GCSE English Language or GCSE English Literature. Students must be participating regularly in at least one sport outside school.

**Photography:** Grade 4 in GCSE Photography or GCSE Art (if taken).

**Physics**: Grades 77 in GCSE Science (combined sciences) or Grade 7 in GCSE Physics (separate sciences) **and** grade 6 in GCSE Maths. *Mathematical Studies will need to be studied in the sixth form as an additional subject, unless A-Level Maths is being studied.* 

**Politics**: Grade 6 in either GCSE English Language or GCSE English Literature.

**Psychology:** Grade 6 in a science **and** grade 5 in either GCSE English Language or GCSE English Literature **and** grade 5 in GCSE Maths. *Mathematical Studies will need to be studied in the sixth form as an additional subject, unless A-Level Maths is being studied.* 

**Religious Studies (Ethics)**: Grade 5 in GCSE RE (if taken) **and** grade 6 in either GCSE English Language or GCSE English Literature.

**Sociology:** Grade 5 in GCSE English Language **and** GCSE English Literature.

### <u>Cambridge Technical Qualifications (CTECs)</u>

CTEC Business Studies: Grade 4 in GCSE Business Studies (if taken).

CTEC Health and Social Care: Grade 4 in GCSE Health and Social Care (if taken).

**CTEC in Digital Media:** No additional specific entry requirements.

**CTEC Sport and Physical Activity:** Grade 4 in GCSE PE or a vocational equivalent (if taken), otherwise grades 54 in GCSE Science (combined sciences) or Grade 5 in GCSE Biology.

#### Other qualifications

**Mathematical Studies:** Taken as an additional qualification. It is available to all students and is compulsory for those studying certain subjects at A Level (see above).
